5. The Committee recommends appointing Berkheimer Associates as school district tax collector for the Schuylkill Haven Borough and Landingville Borough beginning at the start of the 2018 tax year.
6. Mrs. Umphrey presented the board an updated 2018-19 budget overview. As the school budget season progresses, monthly updates will follow.
7. The bills for the month of April are presented and recommended for payment.
